PORTS OF CALL

ROME (CIVITAVECCHIA), ITALY

Civitavecchia was settled in 108 A.D. by the Emperor Trajan and has since served faithfully as a gateway to the capital of the Empire – Rome. Once the center of the Ancient World from which emperors ruled over nearly all of western civilization, Rome is still a cultural Mecca. Stroll the ancient halls of the Colosseum or gaze upon the ceilings of the Sistine Chapel.

ALANYA, TURKEY

Alanya is a popular holiday resort in southern Turkey, east of Antalya. In Alanya you can find some of the best beaches in Turkey. Shore excursions to Ephesus are popular. Alanya has exotic beaches with crystal waters and sandy beaches. The beach is well organized offering water sports, including water skiing.

LIMASSOL, CYPRUS
